

Am I on track to graduate?

12th grade students should have at least 135 credits (estimate) and earn 20 credits per quarter in order to graduate and NOT NEED a 5th period class.

11th grade students should have at least 80 credits (estimate) and earn 20 credits per quarter in order to graduate and NOT NEED a 5th period class.

Because the Del Amigo schedule is constricted, students might have a 5th class because the course might not be available the following quarter.

Alternative Ways to Earn Credit

Work Experience - 5 credits per quarter of electives

-Must have and retain a job throughout the semester and meet with teacher each week.

Edgenuity - Non College prep classes in addition to on site classes, Not instead of **Independent Learning Contract** - Teacher created lessons to earn

DVC Classes - Students can earn up to 10 credits of subject area credits or elective credits based on

- Please bring needed materials to school. If you are in need of materials please let your teacher know.
- If you are late please check into the front counter and then go to class. Enter the classroom in a polite manner that does not interrupt instruction.
- Bathroom privileges are suspended the first 10 and last 10 minutes of class.
